

SALE CONTRACT

Today, March 16, 1868 between partners Peter Regneri, son of Hans and his wife Christina, on the first part and on the second part, the married couple Michael Gesellchen and Anna Maria Regneri, all living in Mehring, the following sale took place.

The married couple Michael and Anna Maria Regneri Gesellchen, who are about to imigrate to America, sold tday all the property of the above named Anna Maria Regneri consisting of movable and un-movable property that came into her rightful possession following the death of her father; also what will be coming to her from her still living mother to the above named Peter Regneri, son of Hans and Christina Regneri, amounting to the total price of 99 thalers, which sum was promptly paid out in cash to the seller.

Besides this sale price, the buyer assumes a share of the burden resting on the house of the seller Anna Maria Regneri, which she will take over and pay off as part of the heritage.

The buyer assumes all obligations the seller had to the extent that it flows form the relationship of the parents of Anna Maria Regneri, wife of Michael Gesellchen that naturally connects.

This above sales contract was made in the presence of 2 witnesses issued in 1 original and 1 copy, and after reading it aloud to all parties was subscribed by them at Mehring.
