This Morning it snowed but this afternoon it was a little better it was quite warm. It's been hot everyday sense Easter. How's the wheather been up there? huh? You got to letters from John & 1 from Aunt Bert today. Write now Pat is reading a magazine & Dan is reading a funny book Albert & Rita are in bed & Jim & Chris are talking. Next week we have tests the 8<sup>th</sup> grade take there exams on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. I sure can't think of any thing to say because nothing happens.
