We received your very nice letter it seemed very good to hear how you all are, we are all purty good, Christin came home two weeks ago last Saturday and she is fine walked up and down stairs and sleepes and eats well she will be right new very soon, she is supposed to go to work the first day of March don't no if she can we will see when the time comes.

Today it was 52 years that I was maried in Wisconsen and it rained and snowed and it got very cold in the nite and after two weekes we started for the West over the Rockie Mountain for Colton, Washington we started the 3 of March and came to Uniontown the 16 and it was raining. now I can't tell you everything that happent since it would be a big storey.

last Sunday the 16 it was 10 years when Papa died a long time ago.

Well, new that you had the electric light in. some one told me about it I was thinking about the wiering weather the wire was all (w)raped good yet so their would not be any fire. Charles and familie are fine he is quit busy and so are the girls.
