I am hoping that this is true. If I don't I will be kept over here for the army of occupation. If I do come back I will, in all probability, be sent to the Pacific after I have a furlough. So I don't know for sure which would be best. Would like to get home again, but sure hate to think of going to the Pacific as that would be rough. About all I am doing is waiting to see what they are going to do with me. If I come home I should be there by the 1st of July.

Not much as happened since I last wrote you. We aren't doing much in the line of work. In fact I think we work harder to keep out of work than if we would do the work in the first place. Complicated, heh!

I haven't been on pass since I last wrote you. and probably won't get out till we leave here. (If I do?) Our mail isn't censored anymore so it is a little easier to write. I don't have to worry about what the censor will think of my letter.

The Lorang Family is sure busy according to your letter. I'll bet that makes all the more work for you. Will be glad when your school is out so you will be able to get some rest. And some much needed sleep! Or are you caught up? Seriously tho, you ought to take a good vacation.

The weather over head has been pretty disagreeable the past week. Too much rain. I think this would be a good country for a duck to live in. Not being a duck I can't say as I enjoy it too much.

Did you find the place I was at on the map? It is quite small so maybe you couldn't find it.

Will close for this time, and keep your your fingers crossed and say a short prayer and I may be back in the good old U.S.A. before long. I'm not setting my hopes too high as I've found there are a lot of disappointments in the army. Write soon.
