In a week of two I will finish all my Bookkeeping and Letter Writing. I have already finished everything else but, Telephoning, and Mimeographing plus a few short and relatively un-important subjects. It will be but a short while now until I will be finishing up. Boy, does that sound good to me.

I haven't decided, as yet, just what I am going to do when I do finish but I do know that I will not stay long in Spokane, unless, I get a very good offer here.


How are things going down there? I would like to come down for a few days again, maybe I can arrange it in a month or so.
