Following is the September 1 Red Cross report as made by Mrs. N. M. Leavitt, Red Cross chairman:

Sewing consists of:

1 lap cover, 20 hours credit;  
6 wash cloths, one and a half hours credit;  
65 kit bags, 97 ½ hours;  
Knitting, 1 Afghan, 80 hours;  
1 V-neck sleeveless sweater, 22 hours;  
3 wash cloths, 6 hours;  
2 pair ankle sox, 8 hours;  
total hours, 251.

Articles made, 81.

Individuals working numbered 12 and groups numbered three.

All sewing now has been given out and anyone having sewing or knitting should turn it in at once so that shipment may be made by next Wednesday. There is no sewing left on hand but there is plenty yarn for knitting. You may call for the yarn at Mrs. Leavitt's home.

Three emergencies were taken care of the past month.
