Well how are you old scout and are you working hard these days? How did you spend the big Fourth?

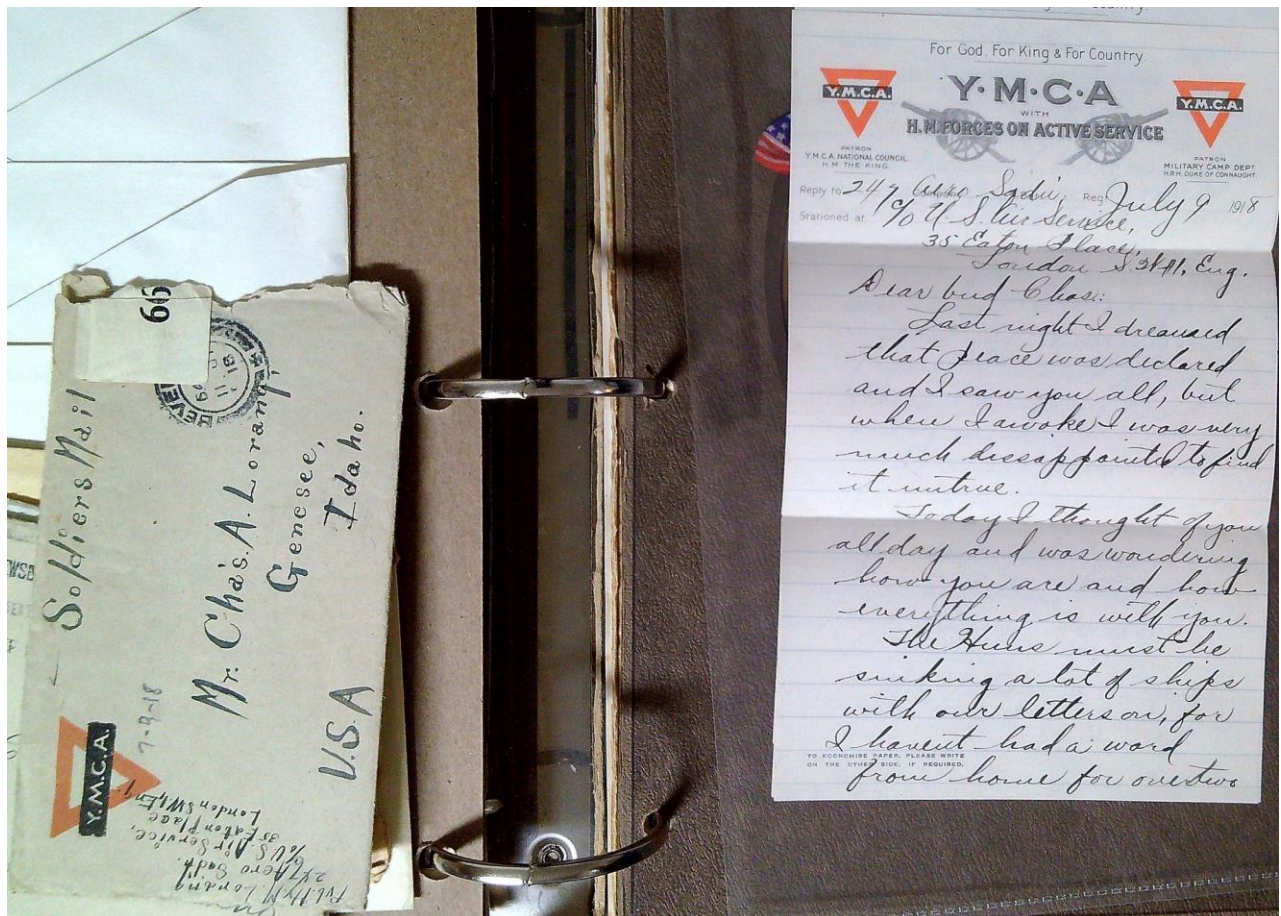
