

July 22, 1944

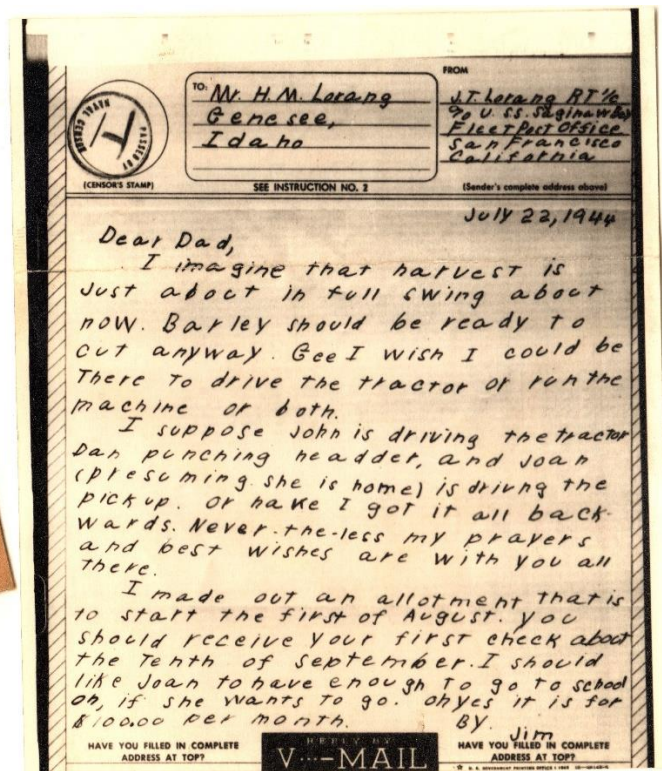
“Dear Dad,
